#### D. Mobile Telephone Service

##### 1. Application of Tariff

This tariff contains rules, regulations and rates applicable to radiotelephone service furnished by the Williston Telephone Company, Inc. d/b/a TDS Telecom, within the Service Areas herein defined in the State of South Carolina.

##### 2. Regulations

###### a. Definition

Radiotelephone service is a communication service providing mobile and fixed radiotelephones through a land radiotelephone base station. Communication service includes service between a wire telephone and a mobile or fixed station radiotelephone, between two mobile or fixed station radiotelephone, dispatching service and signaling service.

###### b. Availability of Service

Radiotelephone service is available to mobile and fixed stations equipped for this service when within range and on the same channel of land radiotelephone base station through which such service is furnished and subject to transmission limitations due to radio propagation conditions.

###### c. Provision of Equipment

(1) The radiotelephone equipment at the mobile station may be provided either by the telephone company or by the customer, as desired. If provided by the customer, the equipment shall be suitable for the proper operation of the service.

(2) All installation work of equipment (equipment includes associated items necessary to the furnishing of service) furnished by the telephone company on the customer's premises and at the mobile station is done by the telephone company. Equipment furnished by the telephone company on the customer's premises and at the mobile station is the property of the telephone company, whose agents and employees have the right to enter the premises and the mobile station at any reasonable hour for the purpose of installing, inspecting or repairing, or upon termination of the service, the removing of the equipment.

c. Provision of Equipment (continued)

(3) Where the customer provides the equipment the above regulation (2) does not apply with the respect of the mobile stations.

d. Undertaking of the Telephone Company

(1) The telephone company's obligation to furnish radiotelephone service is dependent upon its ability to secure and retain suitable facilities and rights for the construction, operation and maintenance of the necessary equipment.

(2) The telephone company does not undertake to transmit messages, but offers the use of its facilities to its customers.

(3) In connection with signaling service, the telephone company undertakes only to transmit a signal for the purpose of actuating a signal at the mobile station and accepts no responsibility for the transmission of further intelligence.

f. Obligation of Customer

(1) The calling party (or customer) shall establish his identity in the course of any communication as often as may be necessary.

(2) The calling party (or customer) shall be solely responsible for establishing the identity of the person or persons with whom connection is made at the called station.

(3) The customer's use of the radio transmitter on the mobile or fixed station shall at all times be subject to the control of the telephone company.

(4) The customer is required to furnish, install and maintain the storage battery and charging equipment on the mobile station required for the proper operation of the service.

- (5) The customer is required to provide and maintain by ownership or rental, adequate power supply at fixed stations for proper operation of the equipment.
- (6) The customer is required to exercise all reasonable precaution to protect the equipment against theft and damages and upon termination, return in good condition all the equipment furnished by the telephone company, reasonable wear and tear excepted.
- (7) The customer is required to make available, for periodic inspection and tests, the mobile station equipment furnished by the telephone company at a time and location mutually agreed upon by the customer and the telephone company.
- (8) The customer must have periodic measurements performed as required by the Federal Communications Commission when the radiotelephone equipment is owned by the customer.

g. Limited Conversation

The telephone company reserves the right to limit the length of local conversations.

h. Liability of Telephone Company

- (1) In view of the possibility of errors and difficulties occurring in the transmission of messages over the facilities furnished by the telephone company and of the other uses for which facilities may be furnished by the telephone company, and because of the inviolableness of such errors and difficulties, the service and facilities furnished by the telephone company are subject to the terms, conditions and limitations herein specified. In the event of an interruption to the service, which is not due to the negligence or willful act of the customer, there will be allowed a prorate adjustment of the monthly guarantee and of any fixed monthly charges involved, for the service and facilities rendered useless and inoperative by reason of the interruption, during the time said interruption continues in excess of twenty-four hours from the time it is reported to the telephone company or detected by the company. For the purpose of administering this regulation, every month is considered to have thirty days.

(2) The amount of the advance payment is credited to the customer's account on the first bill rendered under the contract.

k. Deposits

The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves the applicant or customer from complying with the telephone company's regulations as to advance payments and the prompt payment of bills on presentation. (2) Termination by customer - Service or facilities may be terminated by the customer at any time, subject to payment of full charges for the period service is rendered, except that, if termination occurs within the initial contract period, charges apply for the full initial contract period.

o. Directory and Omissions

p. Denial and Restoral of Service
